Title of Presentation: Carbon Legislation and the Clean Air Act: What's Next?

Brief Presentation Description: As the Senate prepares to consider the Climate Change bill passed by the House last summer, the USEPA continues to take the steps necessary to regulate greenhouse gases under the existing Clean Air Act. In addition to multiple energy law requirements, the Climate Change bill would add two new titles to the Clean Air Act, and establish an economy-wide greenhouse gas cap and trade program. This session will provide an up to the minute briefing on legislative and administrative developments as the U.S. prepares to establish a national greenhouse gas emission reduction program.
